Found - Stone top measures 9"x9", protrudes 5" above ground has a "+" on top. (1904?) C.S. 64/48 Pg. 8  
15" now 34" dia., W.Oak with a fully healed blaze bears N.9°E., 24.0 ft. (orig. rec. N.20°E., 23.1 ft. OBT?) We rescribe on single blaze "SW DLC 44 CS BT"  
Orig. NW BT not found.  
New - Measured from "+" on stone.  
4" dia., D.Fir double blazed and scribed "X BT" bears S.10°E., 8.5 ft.  
30" dia., D.Fir double blazed & scribed "SW DLC 44 CS BT" bears N.27°W., 21.8 ft.  
Corner lies West 9 ft. of a N-S+E fence corner.  
Set - A 5/8"x30" long iron rod with DCSO plastic cap along North edge of stone, protrudes 12" above ground.  
Compass decl. 17½°E.
