I identified the location of this corner by both original BTs
alive and standing. Scribe marks visible and in good
condition. This corner comes at the intersection of an old
N. and S. rail fence and a board fence running W.
Drove an iron pipe 3/4" x 36" for corner.
Set 1 new BT.

Found - 1" O.D. iron pipe protrudes 1" above ground (1928?)
Note - Scattered remains of an old fence found. by metal
detector around area.

Found remains of a Westerly running fence approx.
165 ft. West of IP & 50 ft. South of fence line
found.

We opened two large Oak's. A stump near N.87°W., 660
lks., and a snag with fallen trunk alongside near
N.83°W., 450 lks., no marks found (Note: area
heavily covered with blackberry and Hawthorn
brush)

New - 4" dia., D.Fir double blazed & scribed "X CS BT"
bears N.69½°E., 92.8 ft.

3" dia., D.Fir double blazed & scribed "X BT" bears
N.64°W., 35.3 ft.

4" dia., Hawthorn single blazed & scribed "X BT"
bears N.12½°E., 41.0 ft.

8" dia., W.Oak double blazed & scribed "X CS BT"
bears S.1½°W., 72.0 ft.

Compass decl. 17¾°E
