"Old" Corner Ren. book (hand written)
I identified this corner by a Fir post set by Surveyor Thiel.
Also an original BT, S.10°W., 15 lks. Scribe marks visible
in the bark.
A snag bears S.15°E., 30 lks. This snag has been so badly
burned that all marks are obliterated. It appears from
location however to be the other O.B.T.
Set a 3/4" x 36" Pipe, 30" in the ground for the corner.
Remarked O.B.T., S.10°W., 15 lks.
Also a 30" Fir N.19°E., 5 lks. which had been previously
marked by someone unknown.

I went to the SW corner of the Thomas Stillwell DLC which I
identified by a post set by a previous surveyor also by two
original BTs one of which carried scribe marks the marks on
the other having been burned off. I found the bearings &
distances to be S.15°E., 30 lks. and S.10°W., 15 lks. also a
latter BT N.19°E., 5 lks. I set a 1"x30" pipe for the corner
and remarked all BTs.

1"x30" pipe 50" Fir S.15°E., 30 lks.
50" Fir S.10°W., 15 lks.

C.S. File 2/49 (actual field notes)
Set 1"x30" remark tree
Identified by post set by Thiel - Old BT S ? W

should be S.10°W 15 & S.15°E. ? also BT N.19°E. 5 lks.
