I identified the location of this cor. by the remains of an O.B.T., Now a rotted snag, 8 ft. high, X marks BT reverse visible where it had grown into original scribe marks. Drove a 3/4" x 36" pipe for this corner at proper location from this tree. Surrounded pipe with a mound of stone. Scribed -A 15" Fir N.47°30'W., 92.8 ft. ¼ S13 CS BT.
 A 20" Fir S.16°E., 145.9ft. ¼ S24 CS BT.

Set 1" x 1" x 36" Iron pipe with brass cap beside pipe.

Found - No trace of orig. post found.
We find 3/4" I.P. flush in the ground.
1" x 1" T-Iron, extending 18" above ground alongside 3/4" I.P. with copper washer attached mkd. "Wilford N. Haines 239 Survey Point Drain Oregon"
No trace of original BTs found.
A 20" now 40" D.Fir alive and in good condition with well healed double blaze bears S.16°E., 145.9 ft.
A 15" Fir now a 29" stump with well healed double blaze, bears N.45°W., 93.8 ft. (Rec. N.47½°W., 92.8 ft.)
Set a 1" x 30" I.P., 28" in the ground with brass cap attached marked: Douglas Co. Surveyor
 T22S 1/4 S13 S24 R6W 1978
We place found 3/4" I.P. and 1" T-Iron alongside brass cap. New BT - A 16" D.Fir scribed "¼ S13 CS BT" on a double blaze bears N.36½°E., 22.2 ft.
Corner located near corner of random fences running N & E approx. 40 ft. West of an old road running NE-SW and approx. 60 ft. East of a small draw, course NE.
