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The NE. cor. of Claim No. 41, perpetuated and recorded by  
Haines in 1967, monumented with an iron rod 1/2" dia., firmly  
set, projecting 12" above ground, from which the remains of  
an original bearing tree:

A root hole bears S.25°E., 72 lks. dist. with a down Oak  
alongside, 15" dia., no marks visible on decayed  
blaze.

A Fir 9" dia., bears S.38°E., 7 lks. dist. with healed  
blaze.

A Fir 16" dia., bears S.36°W., 45 1/2 lks. dist. with  
healed blaze.
