The NW cor. of Claim #40, occupied by the original corner
tree, a rotted W.Oak stump, 20" dia., with old axe marks
visible on W. face, from which the original bearing trees:

A root hole bears S.60°E., 45 lks. dist., alongside of
which is a fallen W.Oak 25" dia., with no marks
remaining on opened and rotted blaze.

A stump hole bears S.5°W., 68 lks. dist.

At the corner point

Remove the stump of the original corner tree and set an iron
post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass
cap mkd: T 22 S R 8 W
