<p>Surveys of Donation Land Claims by - Dennis Hathorn, Deputy, dated Sept. 1856</p> <p>-----</p> <p>Set post for a SW cor. Claim 42, from which A Fir 36" dia., bears N.85°E., 34 lks. A Fir 12" dia., bears N.37°W., 63 lks.</p>
<p>Ben B. Irving, Douglas Co. Surveyor - Milo Godfrey, Witness -March 1945 - M 10-72</p> <p>-----</p> <p>The SW ext. cor. and SW Int. cors. for the South boundary of DLC #42 were both gone and all traces thereof lost. The East and West distance along the South bdy. between the SE and SW corners of the DLC #42, failing to agree with the record, I SET a 1/2" x 36" Iron pipe, 33" in the ground for the <u>Southwest Exterior</u> corner West of the SE corner, its proportional distance, from which A Fir 12" dia., bears N.62°W., 24.3 ft. A Fir 24" dia., bears N.10°W., 70.4 ft. (both blazed and scribed "SW Ext DLC 42 CS BT")</p>

Jelley, Cadastral Surveyors, under Group #'s 514 and 350, surveyed June 1963/March 1965 (DCSO records Vol. 33 Page(s) 13690)</p> <p>-----</p> <p>CORNER REPORT (From a point on the section line bet. 22 and 27) the SW Cor. of DLC #42, bears North, 1.62 chs.; reestablished by F.J. Cole, Deputy Co. Surveyor in 1915, monumented with an iron pipe, 1/2" dia., 6" above ground, and with an iron pipe 2" dia., 3½ ft. above ground, set by Irving, Co. Surveyor, in 1945, from which a tree marked in 1945: A sawed Fir stump 20" dia., bears N.87½°W., 30 lks. dist. with scribe marks CS BT visible on opened blaze.</p>

File 52/14-66</p> <p>-----</p> <p>Found - 1/2" Iron pipe set by Irving in 1945, new 1½" galv. I.P. alongside. Stump of 24" Fir N.10°W., 70.4 ft., scribing visible "XT 42 BT" Stump of 12" Fir N.82°W. (not N.62°W.) 24.3 ft., scribing visible. New BTs -10" D.Fir N.87°E., 12.4 ft. mkd. SW DLC 42 CS BT. 5" D.Fir S.68°W., 30.9 ft. mkd. SW DLC 42 CS BT.</p>
