Point for the N. cor. of Claim No. 49, determined by the method of broken boundaries; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

BLM remonumentation by Aaron M. Graham, Cadastral Surveyor and Michael O. Jones Surveying Technician, under Group #2199, surveyed April 2008/April 2009 - (DCSO rec. Vol. 56 Pg 21950)

The N. cor. of DLC No. 49, established by Brooks & Jelley in 1963-65; monumented with an iron post, 2½" dia., firmly set, projecting 6" above ground, with a brass cap (properly) mkd. from which bearing trees mkd by Brooks and Jelley in 1963-65

A fir, 39" dia., bears N.34°E., 36.3 ft., with a healed blaze.
 A fir, 21" dia., bears S.14°W., 4.6 ft., with a healed blaze.
