15" now 29" dia. W.Oak, with a fully healed blaze,
bears N.53½°W., 96.2' (agrees with rec.) 1962
Set- 2¾" dia. Brass cap on a 1¾" O.D. by 32" long iron
pipe is et at referenced position of 3/4" I.R. 1"
below road surface.
3/4" I.R. measured 21" long is set along north edge
of BC/IP 6" below ground.
Note - another 3/4" I.R. found 24" below ground. BC/IP
centered on top of lower I.R.
