The interior NW. cor. of DLC 57, in sec. 9, perpetuated by Frear in 1917, and remonumented by Brooks and Jelley in 1963-65; monumented with an iron post, 1" dia., firmly set, in solid rock, with top flush with the surface of the ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd. from which the remains of the bearing trees mkd. by Brooks and Jelley

A fir, 37" dia., bears S.13½°W., 71.3 ft., with a healed blaze.

A fir, 39" dia., bears N.44°W., 34.2 ft., with a healed blaze. (Record, 36.3 ft.)

and a bearing tree mkd. by person(s) unknown and reported by Roberts in 1997

A maple, 20" dia., bears S.71°E., 9.9 ft., with a healed blaze.

A steel fence post is alongside the cor.

Corner is located on an E. slope, near the top.
