The exterior cor. on the W. bdy. of Claim No. 57, perpetuated
and recorded by Frear in 1917, when the original bearing
trees were existent, monumented with an iron pipe, 1½" dia.,
8" above ground, firmly set, from which bearing trees mkd. by
Frear:

A down Fir 65" dia., bears N.18°E., 125 lks. dist. with a
healed blaze.
A down Fir 24" dia., bears S.24½°E., 12 lks. dist. with a
healed blaze.

At the corner point

The W-NW cor. of DLC 57, in sec. 9, perpetuated by Frear in 1917, and remonumented by Brooks and Jelley in 1963-65; monumented with an iron post, 2½" dia., firmly set, projecting 5" above ground, with brass cap (properly) mkd. from which the remains of an original bearing tree

A decayed fir stump, 59" dia., bears N.18°E., 82.5 ft. no marks visible. Tree is behind a white fir, 6" dia 10 ft and the remains of a BT mkd. by Frear and reported by Brooks and Jelley

A leaning decayed stump, 10" dia., bears S.24½°E., 7.9 ft., no marks visible.
and the remains of the BTs mkd. by Brooks and Jelley

A fir, 28" dia., bears N.41½°E., 37.6 ft., with a healed blaze.

A fir stump, 35" dia., bears S.39°E., 51.5 ft., with a healed blaze.
and a bearing tree mkd. by person(s) unknown and reported by Roberts in 1997

A fir, 29" dia., bears S.67°E., 24.6 ft., with a healed blaze.

A steel fence post is alongside the cor.
Corner is located on a nearly level bench on a generally SE. slope, and N., 140 ft. from a creek, 1 ft. wide, in a gully, course S.30°E.
