

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION 1/4 Cor. for secs. 6 and 7

Alias	Description
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GLO survey by W.H. Byars, Deputy Surveyor under contract # 202 survey dated March 11, 1874 (DCSO records Vol 4 Pg 1590)

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Marked a Fir 14" dia., for ¼ cor. from which  
A Fir 30" dia., bears North, 16 lks. dist.  
A Fir 30" dia., bears S.25°E., 36 lks. dist.

BLM resurvey by Floyd A. Brooks and James E. Jelley, Cadastral Surveyors, under Group #'s 514 and 350, surveyed June 1963/March 1965 (DCSO records Vol. 33 Page(s) 13706)

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The ¼ sec. cor., monumented with the original corner tree, a down Fir, 15" dia., with scribe marks ¼ S visible on bark blaze, from which the original bearing trees:

A sawed Fir stump 32" dia., bears N.7°E., 20 lks. dist., with partial scribe marks visible on bark blaze. (Rec. brg. & dist., North 16 lks.)

A Fir snag 25" dia., bears S.20°E., 38 lks. dist. with scribe marks BT visible on bark blaze. (Rec. brg. & dist., S.25°E., 36 lks.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28" long, 2 1/2" dia., 22" in the ground, with brass cap mkd:

from which a new bearing tree

A Fir 18" dia., bears N.19½°W., 85 lks. mkd. ¼ S6 BT.

Set a 7 ft. steel fence post, 24" in the ground, alongside the iron post.

32" D.Fir stump, N.7°E., 13.2 ft. rotten face.

23" D.Fir, N.19½°W., 56.1 ft. healed face.

New BT - 10" D.Fir, N.84°W., 14.0 ft. scribed "¼ S5 BT"

BLM remonumentation by Aaron M. Graham, Cadastral Surveyor and Michael O. Jones Surveying Technician, under Group #2199, surveyed April 2008/April 2009 - (DCSO rec. Vol. 56 Pg 21945)

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The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, perpetuated by Brooks and Jelley in 1963-65; monumented with an iron post, 2½" dia., firmly set, projecting 1" above ground, with a brass cap (properly) mkd.

A fir, 31" dia., bears N.19½°W., 56.1 ft., with a healed  
blaze.  
and a bearing tree mkd. by Minor in 1994  
A fir, 10" dia., bears S.49°W., 14.0 ft., with a healed  
blaze.
