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BLM resurvey by Floyd Brooks and Peter Peterson, Cadastral Surveyors - under Group #'s 595 and 657 - surveyed Aug. 1965/Dec. 1967 - (DCSO records Vol. 34 Page(s) 14130)

 Point for the center ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 29, at intersection with the E. and W. center line.

Set an iron post 28" long, 2½" dia., 24" in the ground, with brass cap marked: C ¼ S 29

A Fir 6" dia., bears S.6½°E., 302 lks. dist. mkd. C ¼ S29 BT.

A W.Fir 19" dia., bears S.86°W., 336 lks. dist. mkd. C ¼ S29 BT.

 Found - 1965 BLM brass cap properly mkd. on a 2½" x 28" I.P. Monument is pulled out of soil and lying on surface because of recent land clearing. No evidence of the monument's original position remains. (Record of date stamped on cap is 1964).

An orig. 6" Fir now 17" by 8 ft. tall Fir stump which is opened to find part of the remaining scribing which reads "S2"

From the preceeding stump, we measure N.6½°W., 199.3 ft. (302 lks.) to approx. the orig. location of the monument. From this position, we find an orig. 19" now a 29" DBH W.Fir bearing S.86°W., 218.2 ft. This tree is partially opened to find the scribing "C 1/4".

The most acceptable corner position is found to be at intersection of the original distance. From this position:

The 17" dia. x 8 ft. tall Fir stump now bears S.05½°E., 199.3 ft. and the

29" W.Fir bears N.86½°W., 211.8 ft.

Upon measuring to the point of orig. intersection distances and finding reasonable bearings to the orig. BTs, this position is referenced out and the monument is replaced in the ground at this determined orig. location. The monument now protrudes 2" from the ground and is firmly set. WE ADD "RESET C.S. 1980" to stamping on brass cap.

New BTs -25" DBH W.Fir bears N.84°E., 118.7 ft. Tree is scribed "C ¼ S29 CS BT" on a double blaze and is located in a random E-W fenceline.

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An 8" D.Fir bears N.64°W., 215.3 ft. Tree scribed "C
¼ S29 CS BT" on a double blaze.
All trees are retagged or tagged with DCSO BT tags.
Monument is 53 ft. South of a random E-W fenceline.
