all grown over. Had the new growth cut away leaving the
original marks very distinct.
The other, a Fir 36" dia., bears N.5°E., 115 lks. dist.,
is distinctly marked on the bark.

A Fir snag 18" dia., bears N.19°E., 32½ lks. dist., with scribe marks NE COR DLC 39 BT visible on opened blaze. and bearing trees mkd. by Powell:

A Fir 14" dia., bears N.61¼°E., 52 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A Fir 11" dia., bears N.74°W., 50 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and a new bearing tree:

A Fir 8" dia., bears S.74°W., 60 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R9W C39 BT.
