Set Fir post 4½ ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground at the point of intersection, on steep hillside sloping SW. for closing corner to secs. 28 and 29, marked C.C. on the North, T22S S28 on the E.; and R9W S29 on the West side, with 1 groove on S. and 4 grooves on the E. sides, from which,
A Fir 30" dia., bears N.60°E., 63 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R9W S28 BT.
A Fir 36" dia., bears S.76°W., 38 lks. dist. mkd. C.C. T22S R9W S28-29 BT.
A Fir 50" dia., bears N.61°W., 12 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R9W S29 BT.

Corner searched for, not found. Fd. unrecorded 1¼" I.P. and cap mkd. 29|28 and possible old BTs. NW & NE. decayed no 32 scribe. Using slope dist. from face, these stumps would fit fairly well.

The original closing cor. of secs. 28 and 29, perpetuated by person(s) unknown, monumented with an iron post, 2" dia., firmly set, projecting 8" above ground, with brass cap mkd. S28 S29 S33, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:
A burned and decayed Fir stump, size indeterminate, bears N.60°E., 63 lks. dist., no marks visible.
A sawed Fir stump 60" dia., bears N.61°W., 12 lks. dist. with scribe marks T2 visible on open blaze.
I add marks AM 1974 to brass cap.
