A Chinquapin 4" dia., bears S.45°W., 12 lks. dist. mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT.

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Found - Orig. 5" Fir corner tree, now 16" dia. with  $\frac{1}{4}$  S scribing visible on partially opened West face.

24" Fir bears N.17°00'W., 8.2 ft. scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S33 BT.

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Found - 5" now 16" dia. D.Fir with scribing visible on opened West blaze " $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Original corner tree.  
28" now 29" dia. D.Fir with a partially healed single blaze, illegible scribing visible, bears N.51 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 32.4 ft. (agrees w/rec.)  
24" now 27" dia. D.Fir with a partially healed single blaze, scribing visible "  $\frac{1}{4}$  S33 BT" bears N.17°W., 8.2 ft. (agrees w/rec.)  
New BTs -24" dia. D.Fir double blazed and scribed " $\frac{1}{4}$  S33 CS BT", bears S.22°W., 5.2 ft.  
14" D.Fir double blazed and scribed " $\frac{1}{4}$  S34 CS BT" bears S.87°E., 21.7 ft.
