A Fir 14" dia., bears N.63°E., 24 lks.
A Laurel 10" dia., bears S.24°W., 10 lks.

GLO survey by Aurelius Todd, Deputy Surveyor, under Contract #629, dated April 24, 1894 - (DCSO recs Vol. 5 Pgs 1822-23)

Set a Post 4 ft. long, 4" sq., 24" in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. mkd. with ¼ S. on W. face, from which
A Maple 6" dia., bears N.35°W., 25 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT
A Fir 48" dia., bears N.89°E., 40 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT.

Survey by Ronald Stuntzner - For: Westbrook Land & Timber - July 1989 - M 108-41

Found - 48" Fir, original, now a 10 ft. high snag, N.89°E., 26.4 ft. with face. Scribes are rotted away.
Creek is 4.0 chs. South and matches GLO distance.
Set a 3/4" Iron rod with 2" alum. cap 30" long, stamped "Stuntzner Engr."
New BTs -I scribed a 36" Fir N.81°W., 14.4 ft.
I scribed a 14" Chittum, N.41°E., 41.1 ft.

Harvey Wilcox - For: Jerry Harris - Aug. 1991 -M 113-76 A&B

This 1/4 Corner has been reset from the original position as set. (See Stuntzner's survey M 108-41). Pulled out the old iron rod and chopped off the blazes on the BTs. The new 1/4 corner bears N.64°08'08"E., 147.67 ft. from old corner.
Set 3/4" Iron rod w/alum. cap mkd. "Stuntzner Engineering T22S R10W ¼ S14|S13 1991 LS 2244"
New BTs -15" Fir bears S.81°W., 19.3 ft. scribed "¼ S14 BT" with X and tags.
15" Alder bears N.83°E., 33.0 ft. bark scribed "¼ S13 BT" with X and tags.
17" Alder bears S.27°E., 43.4 ft. bark scribed "¼ S13 BT" with X and tags.
51" Fir bears S.16°W., 43.3 ft. scribed "¼ S14 BT" with X and tags.
