A Chittem 12" dia., bears S.12°W., 27 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT.  
A Vine Maple 6" dia., bears N.72°W., 85 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT.

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Original post, found rotten remains, from which a  
12" Chittem bears S.12°W., 27 lks.; now uprooted 14" log, with 6" Chittem growing from same log 10 ft. from butt.  
6" Vine Maple bears N.72°W., 85 lks.; 12" Vine Maple clump in place.  
Creek bears East 195 lks.; now in place.  
Top of ridge bears West 230 lks.; now in place.  
Orig. Line blaze approx. 4 chs. West.  
Set 1½" x 36" galv. I.P. with 3" bronze cap mkd. "Oregon State Board of Forestry ¼ S19 S30 1961 RS 359", 33" in ground and from which a:  
34" Cedar bears N.78°W., 75.5 ft. scribed ¼ S19 BT RS 359.  
48" Cedar bears S.58°W., 71.4 ft. scribed ¼ S30 BT.  
OSBF metal location poster on 6" Chittem, S.8°W., 6.0 ft.
