At a point 5.75 chs. South of cor. to secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29 I set a stone 20x12x10 ins., 14" in ground for closing cor. to secs. 20 and 29, mkd. CC with 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on E. edges, from which

- A Cherry 6" dia., bears S.75°W., 24 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S29 BT.
- A Cherry 7" dia., bears N.48°W., 20 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S20 BT.
- A Myrtle 6" dia., bears N.81°E., 20 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W CC S20 & 29 BT.

Orig. stone 20x12x10", found in place, badly sloughed, 1 notch and other chisel work remaining on W. side, from which
6" Cherry bears S.75°W., 24 lks.; rotted and down, root hole in place.

- 7" Cherry bears N.48°W., 20 lks.; clump of Cherries in place, old face on one.
- 6" Myrtle bears N.81°E., 20 lks.; large clump of 17 in place.

Set 1½" x 36" galv. I.P. 3" bronze cap mkd: "Ore. St. Bd. of Forestry T22S R11W S20 S29 CC S28 1966 RS 359", 28" in ground, on North side of corner stone, in mound of rock and from which a:

- 12" Myrtle bears N.83½°E., 15.9 ft. scribed T22S R11W S28 BT.
- 10" Myrtle, in clump of 11, bears South 8.4 ft. scribed T22S R11W CC S29 BT RS 359.
- 53" Fir bears N.9°W., 49.4 ft. scribed T22S R11W CC S20 BT
- 4"x4"x72" white painted cedar post 1.5 ft. SW of corner pipe.
- OSBF metal location poster on 12" Myrtle BT.
