Set a post 4 ft. long and 4" sq., 2 ft. in the ground for the cor. to secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29, marked T22S S21 on NE.; R11W S28 on SE.; S29 on SW.; and S20 on NW. faces, with 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on E. edges, from which
A Myrtle 5" dia., bears N.4°E., 24 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S21 BT.
A Cherry 5" dia., bears S.6°E., 24 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S28 BT.
A Cherry 6" dia., bears S.37°W., 23 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S29 BT.
A Cherry 4" dia., bears N.30°W., 5 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S20 BT.
