A Willow 4" dia., bears N.74°E., 10 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S3 BT.
An Alder 3" dia., bears S.31°W., 50 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S9 BT.
A Willow 5" dia., bears N.11°W., 8 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S4 BT.
No other trees in limits.
A bluff of rock, 4 ft. high bears South 4 lks. dist.

rock bluff in place, scribes X B0 (2" letters) 2 ft. up
from bottom.
