An Alder 10" dia., bears S.8°E., 28 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S23 BT.  
A Fir 10" dia., bears S.31°W., 71 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S22 BT.  
A Fir 8" dia., bears N.36°W., 26 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S15 BT.

A Fir stump 16" dia., with marks R11W S22, bears S.31°W., 71 lks. Both trees badly decayed.  
From the corner,  
An 8" Alder bears N.83°E., 6 lks. which I blazed and drove 3 8d nails, bent to cross.  
Set Cedar post by cor. with flag.

8" Fir bears N.36°W., 26 lks.; now rotted 1 ft. high stump, portion of scribe T remaining.

Cedar post, found 4'x4'x8", on N. side of corner stone, from which  
8" Alder bears N.83°E., 6 lks.; found, now 12" overgrown
