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At a point 9.24 chs. N.1°30'E. from cor. to 3 and 10  
Set a sandstone 16x12x12 ins., 11" in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 2 and 11 marked CC with 2 notches on E. and 5 notches on S. edges, from which  
    A Willow 3" dia., bears N.28½°E., 44 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S2 BT.  
    A burnt Fir 40" dia., bears S.78°E., 151 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R11W S11 BT.  
No other trees in limits.  
Pits and mound impracticable.

4 x 4 Elliott Survey cedar post, 3.0 ft. SE of corner stone.
