Set ¼ sec. cor. a stone 18x10x6. No trees near cor.

GLO survey by William R. Whipple, Deputy Surveyor, under Contract #612, dated April 28, 1893 (DCSO records Vol. 5 Page(s) 1973)

I make diligent search for the ¼ sec. cor. which is described as being a stone 18x10x6 ins. but am unable to find any trace of it.

Set a sandstone 16x14x6 ins., 11" in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. marked ¼ on W. side.

A Maple 4" dia., bears N.63°W., 10 lks. dist. which I mark ¼ S BT.

An Alder 3" dia., bears N.82°E., 27 lks. dist. which I mark ¼ S BT.
