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Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4" sq., 2 ft. in the ground for cor. to secs. 25, 26, 35, & 36, marked T22S S 25 on NE, R11W S 36 on SE, S 35 on SW, S 26 on NW faces, with 1 notch on S & E edges; from which  
A fir, 8" dia., bears N.38°E., 83 lks., mkd: T30S R1W S25 BT.  
A burnt fir, 40" dia., bears S.52°E., 113 lks., mkd: T30S R1W S36 BT.  
A fir, 10" dia., bears S.87°W., 101 lks., mkd: T30S R1W S35 BT.  
A fir, 10" dia., bears N.64°W., 78 lks., mkd: T30S R1W S26 BT.

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Corner consists of a iron pipe in place, condition fair, 6" above ground.  
8" D.Fir N.38°E., 54.8', closed. Orig. Dia.'s.  
10" D.Fir S.87°W., 66.7', closed. Orig. Dia.'s.  
10" D.Fir N.64°W., 51.5', closed. Orig. Dia.'s.  
Note - Corner lies just off N side of Umpqua rd. about 700' W of the elk wallow waterhole.

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Found - 1½" ID iron pipe flush with ground. (Source unknown)  
8" now 57" dia., D.Fir no blaze visible bear N.38°E., 54.8 ft. (agrees w/rec.) OBT  
10" now 45" dia., D.Fir with healed scar, original record S.87°W., 66.7 ft. looks good, younger tree on line makes direct measurement difficult. OBT  
10" now 48" dia., 2 ft. high rotted D.Fir stump bears N.64°W., 51.5 ft. (agrees with rec.) OBT.  
Set - 5/8"x60" long iron rod with DCSO Alum. cap stamped "2010" in middle of found IP protrudes 1 ft. out of ground.  
15" dia., D.Fir double blazed & scribed "T22S R11W S35 CS BT" bears S.51°W., 5.5 ft.  
No trees SE of corner.  
Note - Corner lies 60 ft. North of the center line of a gravel road. Dec. 16°E
