Set a Cedar post, 4" sq., 5 ft. long, 2 ft. in ground for meander corner to fractional secs. 30 and 31, marked MC on East; T22S S30 on North; S31 on South; and R12W on West, from which

A Cedar 45" dia., bears S.60°W., 29 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R12W S31 MC BT.

A Fir 30" dia., bears N.38°E., 34 lks. dist. mkd. T22S R12W S30 MC BT.

Found - Orig. BT, a Cedar stump with machette marks and burnt face, bears S.60°W., 19.14 ft.

New BTs -33" Spruce scribed "MC S30 BT" with an X at BH and tagged, bears N.33°W., 19.7 ft.

22" D.Fir scribed "MC S31 BT" with an X at BH and tagged, bears S.15°W., 26.5 ft.
