Set post corner of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, from which
A Spruce 30" dia., bears S.73°W., 28 lks. dist.
A Spruce 18" dia., bears N.70°W., 76 lks. dist.
A Spruce 30" dia., bears N.7°E., 72 lks. dist.
A Spruce 5" dia., bears S.79°E., 38 lks. dist.

Found - 30" Spruce now a 36" dia. decayed stump bearing N.7°E., 47.5 ft. We remove pitch from a previously opened blaze and find faint scribing "T R 12". The figures R 12 being the most legible.

Original 1857 4 x 4 post, not found.

At record bearing and distance (S.7°W. 47.5 ft.) from the found evidence, We set a temporary point and search for the remaining BT evidence as follows:

A 30" Spruce bearing S.73°W., 18.5 ft. We find rotted remains of a Spruce, size indeterminate, bears S.76°W., 18.0 ft. No blaze or scribe found.

A Spruce 18" dia., bearing N.70°W., 50.2 ft. We find a badly decayed stump, size indeterminate, bears N.70°W., 45.5 ft. No blaze or scribing found.

We found no sign of the 5" dia., Spruce at S.79°E., 25.1 ft.

At the temporary point noted at record bearing and distance from the found NE BT stump, WE SET a 1" x 30" Iron pipe with a brass cap attached and stamped: "Douglas Co. Surveyor T22S S8 S9 S17 S16 R12W 1982". Monument protrudes 10" above ground. New BTs -R.Cedar 15", double blazed and scribed "T22S R12W S8

CS BT" bears N.31°W., 14.5 ft.

Spruce 20", double blazed and scribed "T22S R12W S9 CS BT" bears N.85°E., 22.6 ft.

R.Cedar 14", double blazed and scribed "T22S R12W S16 CS BT" bears S.35½°E., 18.8 ft.

R.Cedar 14", double blazed and scribed "T22S R12W S17 CS BT" bears S.73°W., 22.3 ft.

All new BTs tagged.
