Set a Fir post, 3 ft. long, 3" sq., 24" in the ground for ¼ sec. cor. mkd. ¼ S on N. face, from which
A Cedar 20" dia., bears S.20°W., 20 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT
A Cedar 18" dia., bears N.30°E., 36 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT

Survey by A.N. Gould - June 1916 - Gould Field Book 53 Page 119 - (DCSO records, C.S. File 62/35)

Found BTs as follows:
Cedar 24", S.20°W., 20 lks.
Cedar 20", N.30°E., 13 ft. instead of 36 lks. as per notes.

Search for the ¼ corner but can find no trace of it, therefore I SET a 1" pipe at the proportion distance and on the true line, and mark two new bearing trees as follows:
Alder 18" DBH, bears N.87°00'W., 44.8 ft.
Alder 24" DBH, bears S.79°00'W., 49.5 ft.

Found - 24" now 21" Alder, scribe illegible, bears S.79°W., 49.5 ft.
18" now 16" Alder snag 13 ft. high. No scribe visible. Tagged "Moore Lo. Co. S21 Twp 22 R 12 S 1/4 Cor."

Did not find 1" I.Pipe.

Set brass cap 3" dia. at ¼ cor. stamped: "T22S R2W ¼ S21 S28 1976 Douglas County Surveyors Office". Position of cap determined by DCSO project #6004-16. Brass cap set in drill hole in rock. See C.S. 59/15-1 attached pages for computations.

New BTs -An Alder 15" bears S.48°09'E., 32.0 ft. Tree double blazed and scribed "¼ S28 CS BT"

An Alder 16" bears N.26°40'E., 34.0 ft. Tree double blazed and scribed "¼ S21 CS BT"

Set steel fence post and witness sign, S.60°W., 2.5 ft. from corner.

Corner falls on a steep rock face, sloping NE.
