

PRIMARY CORNER DESCRIPTION Center 1/4 Cor. for Sec. 4

(This survey marker location was brought to our attention by Mr. Stephen Waite, a resident of Reedsport, Oregon.)

Found - A 1" I.P. nearly rusted away with wooden plug and nail inside.

A 12" Red Alder, alive and in fair condition, with illegible scribing visible on partially healed blaze. We open the lower portion of the blaze and find scribing "4 399". This tree bears S.15°E., 27.9 ft. from the found I.P.

An 18" D.Fir alive with well healed single blaze, bears S.25°W., 22.0 ft.

Condition report only. No monument or accessories set. Corner located approx. 100 ft. South of the Catholic Church and approx. 21 ft. East of power pole AG 043 4.

Information filed in C.S. File 59/46-73 states "4/19/83 talked with Hootman via tel from Reedsport. Believes corner established many years ago. Was used for orig. Reedsport Cemetery tie and other subds. Was not established by Hootman but in the process of an uncompleted survey for Burnhart, his crew probably mkd. BTs. Records destroyed by fire."

Found? - 1" I.D. Iron pipe in 5" dia. concrete post, flush with round. Source unknown.

1" I.D. by 16" long rusted iron pipe is found loose in ground along South edge of I.P. in concrete, protruding 12" above ground. Source unknown.

12" now 14" dia. 6 ft. high Alder stump with a partially healed blaze, no scribing visible, bears S.15°E., 27.9 ft. (agrees with rec. mkd. by RLS 399?)

18" now 24" dia., 1½ ft. high D.Fir stump with a healed lower blaze bears S.25°W., 22.0 ft. (agrees with record, mkd. by RLS 399?)

New Accessories:

NW corner of two car garage at Catholic Church bears N.58½°E., 72.5 ft.

SW corner of chapel, 0.3 ft. West of double doors, bears N.53¼°W., 124.2 ft.

Power pole "AG 043 4" bears N.72°W., 20.0 ft.

Monument is approx. 100 ft. South of Catholic Church.

TOWNSHIP 22 RANGE 12 POINT IDENTIFIER # 340640

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Monument is a survey point, unsure how location derived.
BT stumps to be removed for cemetery expansion.
