center healed double blaze.

14" Shore pine S.12°E. 61.8ft scribes BT visible on  
partly healed double blaze. Add 3½" mag nail right  
side center.

Notes - Mon approx 70ft south of base of south jetty wall of  
Umpqua River.

Dune now covered with vegetation salal, pine, spruce.
