54" D.Fir stump rotten bears N.35½°W., 81.9 ft (rec N.35°W., 79.2 ft. No visible scar. County tag  
NEW 13 D.Fir bears S.65°E., 28.6 ft visible scribing not painted no tag no record.  
26" D.Fir bears N.13°W., 137.95 ft (rec. N11°W., 138.6 ft. Well healed face and county tag  
26" D.Fir bears N.1°W., 25.9 ft (rec North 25.7 ft. Well healed face and county tag  
29" D.Fir stump bears S.28½°E., 26.8 ft as per record well healed face and tag  
Corner is 1.0 ft above ground in east-west fence line.

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 7 & 18, perpetuated by Byron, in 1959, further perpetuated by the Douglas County Surveyors Office in 1979, monumented with an iron post, 1¼" dia., firmly set, projecting 14" above the ground, with brass cap (properly)mkd.  
from which the remains of the original bearing trees  
A sawed fir stump, 44" dia., bears S.66°W., 10.6 ft., with no marks visible.  
A sawed fir stump, 68" dia., bears N.35°W., 81.9 ft. with no marks visible. (Record, 79.2 ft.)  
and the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Byron  
A fir, 27" dia., bears North, 25.8 ft., with a healed double blaze.  
A sawed fir stump, 29" dia., bears S.29°E., 26.9 ft., with no marks visible.  
and the remains of a bearing tree mkd. by the Douglas County Surveyors Office in 1979  
A fir snag, 26" dia., bears N.12½°W., 138.2 ft., with a healed double blaze.  
and a new bearing tree  
A fir, 7" dia., bears S.74°E., 28.4 ft., mkd. ¼ S18 BT.  
Corner is located in an unmaintained barbed wire fence, with fences extending East and West.  
Each new bearing tree has a 2½"x ¼" magnetic nail (Mag Nail) driven at the base right side-center, unless otherwise described in the corner description
