NEW 12" D.Fir bears S.25°E., 21.2 ft. visible scribing & 8/07 dated BLM tag.  
20" D.Fir sloped stump bears S.66½°W., 69.9 ft. (rec. S.66¾°W., 70.3 ft.) Well healed face.  
23" D.Fir bears N.70¼°W., 20.7 ft. (rec. N.68°W., 21.0 ft.) well healed face & BLM tag.  
72" D.Fir bears S.37°E., 59.2 ft. (rec. S.36°E., 60.72 ft.) Well healed face & BLM tag.  
24" D.Fir bears N.21°E., 72.1 ft. (rec. N.23°E., 72.3 ft.) well healed face & BLM tag.  
Found BC 1.2 ft. above ground (in pile of rocks) A fence corner is 90 ft. South of brass cap.

A fir, 35" dia., bears N.22°E., 73.3 ft., with a healed double blaze.  
A fir, 23" dia., bears N.70¾°W., 21.1 ft., with a healed double blaze.

driven at the base right side-center, unless otherwise
