The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 8 and 17, established by Haines in 1963, by proportionate measurement, there is no remaining evidence of the original corner, therefore this position is accepted as the cor., monumented with a "T" shaped iron rod, 1" dia., firmly set, projecting 11 ins. above the ground, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Haines
 A fir, 40" dia. bears S.33¾°E. 25.2 ft. with healed blaze
 A sawed cedar stump, 20" dia., bears N.39¼°W., 22.4 ft., with no marks visible.

At the corner point
Set a stainless steel post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 25" in the ground, directly over the "T" shaped iron rod, with brass cap mkd.
