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Found - 2½" brass cap n a 2" iron pipe protrudes 3" out of ground (properly marked)  
24" now 28" dia., Hemlock with scribing visible "N1/16 S14 BT" on opened double blaze, record N.66°E., 12.5 ft. goes to nail in base. Center of root crown bears N.63°E., 13.8 ft. 1991  
NW BT tip out record N.37°W., 17.1 hits root hole 1991  
New BT - 13" dia., R.Cedar double blazed & scribed "CN 1/16 S14 CS BT" bears N.74°W., 27.4 ft.  
Note - Corner lies south approx 150 ft. from old logging road.  
Compass decl. 16½°E.

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Found - 2" Brass cap & pipe mkd T23S R4W CN 1/16 S14 PLS 752 1991  
16" Western red cedar bears N.73¾°W. 27.3' (Rec N.74°W. 27.4') with partially visible scribe "1/16 S1 and D.C. tag.  
30" Western hemlock bears N.61°E. 13.8' (Rec N.63°E. 13.8') partially visible rotten scribe and Weyerhaeuser tag.  
Bedrail bears N.78°38'17"E. 38.82' (N.79°13'09"E. 38.97')  
Notes - Mon. lies on a steep north facing slope in mature timber stand, approx. 100' south of an old logging road. The top of the mon. is 0.3' above ground level. We placed a 5½' tall steel galvanized U-post 1.0' north.
