12" Fir, N.21°W., 7.3 ft.  
8" R.Cedar, N.30°E., 16.3 ft.

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The center ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 11, established by Haines, in 1961, and is accepted as the cor., monumented with a 1x1" "T" shaped iron rod, firmly set, projecting 6" above the ground, with brass button, 1" dia., affixed to top, mkd. SURVEY POINT WILFORD N HAINES 239 DRAIN ORE, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Haines

A cedar, 24" dia., bears N.30°E., 16.1 ft., with a healed blaze.

A sawed & decayed fir stump, 21" dia., bears N.22¼°W., 7.3 ft., with a healed blaze.

At the corner point  
Set a stainless steel post, 28" long, 2½" dia., 21" in the ground, directly over the "T" shaped iron rod, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 5" dia., bears N.55½°W., 5.8 ft., mkd. C¼ S11 BT. Each new bearing tree has a 2½"x ¼" magnetic nail (Mag Nail) driven at the base right side-center.

Deposit a magnet in a white plastic case at the base of the stainless steel post.  
Corner is located in a woven wire fence, extending north and south.

30" W.Red Cedar at record N.30°E., 16.1 ft. BLM tag and well healed face

9"x7' tall G.Fir stump at record N.55½°W., 5.8 ft. BLM tag and well healed face
