At SW corner, I scribed: 26" D.Fir "SWC DLC 40 BT", bears N.42°W., 13.7 ft. 32" D.Fir "SWC DLC 40 BT", bears N.74°E., 11.4 ft. Corner lies at SWC of Yoncalla Cemetery and on North fence-line of a large cleared pasture to the South.</p>

Stone measures 12" x 14" x 24" (orig) I.Rod set by Haines, Yoncalla Cemetery.</p> <p>A 26" D.Fir now 20", bears N.42°W., 14.7 ft., visible scribing "BT" pitched over in a double blaze.</p> <p>A 32" D.Fir now 24" stump, 3 ft. high, bears N.74°E., 11.4 ft. visible scribing "SWC DLC 40 BT" in double blaze.</p> <p>No new monument set. New BT - A 14" Madrone scribed "SWC DLC 40 CS BT" in bark scribe bears N.34°W., 46.1 ft. Corner lies at SWC of cemetery and in North fence line of large clear pasture to the South.</p>

(agrees w/rec) Brgs. and dist. taken from center of orig. stone.</p> <p>26" now a shattered stump of indeterminable size, no scribing or blazes found, bears N.42°W., 14.2 ft. (agrees w/rec) Brg. and dist. taken from center of orig. stone.</p> <p>14" now 16" dia. Madrone with shallow bark scribing "SWC DLC 40 CS BT" bears N.34°E., 46.2 ft. (Rec. N.34°W., 46.1 ft., bearing recorded in wrong quadrant and dist. is to 5/8" I.R.) Brg. and Dist. taken from center of orig. stone.</p> <p>New BT - 26" dia., 4 ft. high D.Fir stump with a boat spike through a BT tag set on top. Boat spike stamped "B0 1" bears West, 11.1 ft. Brg. and dist. taken from center of orig. stone.</p> <p>Corner lies at SW corner of Yoncalla Cemetery at the intersection of an E-W and North fence line.</p>

(firmly set &amp; undisturbed) Orig. mon.)</p> <p>A 5/8" dia IR firmly set &amp; protruding 6" above ground is set on north edge of above found stone mon. and bears north, 0.7 ft. from stones center. 1967</p> <p>New - Bearing &amp; dists. from top center of stone monument.</p> <p>A 10x26 ft concrete slab m/l flush with ground which contains the George Cutlack Family burial plot; the SW corner of which bears N.38°E., 59.7 ft.</p> <p>A 49" DBH D.Fir (double trunked 10 ft. above ground) scribed "SW DLC 40 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears N.78°E., 49.0 ft.</p>
