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Set stone post 6x8x18 inches, from which  
A B.Oak 24" dia., bears N.45°E., 109 lks.  
A B.Oak 15" dia., bears S.3½°W., 146 lks.  
(Applegate's grist mill bears SW about 6 chs.)

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Location identified from original BT:  
Oak, S.3½°W., 96.4 ft., rotted out, but scribe marks still  
visible.  
Original corner rock lying along side field fence.  
An Oak S.50°E., 55.3 ft. bearing scribe marks dead and  
fallen, reputedly marked by O.F. Theil about 30 years  
ago.  
Reset original stone 6" x 8" x 12", 12" under ground and  
drove a 1" Pipe along side, from which  
An Oak 28" dia., bears S.50°E., 88.5 ft.

I do not find stone or I.P. at DLC corner.  
Property owner remembers B. Irving setting cor. but hasn't  
seen it for years. Cor. is in barn yard and orchard fence  
line. Could have been destroyed.

New BT - 18" W.Oak bears N.37°E., 136.8 ft. scribed "NE DLC 42 CS BT (2 blazes)  
This corner lies in barn yard and orchard fence line, at the end of Hale Road. (sketch in CS File)
