Orig. 40" Pine now hollowed out stump of indeterminate size with 16" dia., P.Pine growing out of it. Only a few stubs are left of orig. stump. Checks well with rec. OBT.
32" now 37" dia., W.Oak, fully healed double blaze visible bears N.64°E., 181.0 ft. (agrees w/rec) 1976 BT
Set - 2½" dia., brass cap on 1¼" O.D. x 30" iron pipe, 24" in ground. Position was established using fd accessories & fitting with rec. information. BC mkd: DOUGLAS CO SURVEYORS OFFICE
