49" D.Fir bears N.6°E., 8.0 ft. bark scribed and BT tag. (No record)  
Painted faces and wrote BT on tree trunks of BTs with fluorescent orange paint. Corner sits on East edge of clear cut approx. 150 ft. SW of landing.

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The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 16, monumented with an iron post, 1" dia., firmly set, projecting 3" above ground, with a brass cap (properly) mkd.  
from which the remains of BTs mkd. by Gould, Gawron, & Eggen  
A fir, 9" dia., bears S.46°E., 23.1 ft., with a healed blaze.  
A decayed fir stump, 11" dia., bears S.62½°W., 45.5 ft., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on a partially healed blaze.  
and a new bearing tree  
A fir, 10" dia., bears S.35½°W., 19.8 ft., mkd. ¼ S16 BT.  
From this cor., a point established by Haines, in 1956, bears N.80°23'53"W., 6.51 ft., monumented with a "T" shaped iron rod, 3/4" dia., firmly set, projecting 8" above ground, with a brass washer mkd. WILFORD N HAINES SURVEY 239 DRAIN, ORE., with a tack in center, from which bearing trees mkd. by Haines (misidentified by Rogers, et al, in 1986-95, as BTs mkd. by person(s) unknown for the ¼ sec. cor of secs 15 & 16)  
A fir, 54" dia., bears N.49¾°E., 9.4 ft., with scribe marks ¼ S 239 BT visible on bark.  
A fir, 32" dia., bears S.28¾°E., 35.4 ft., with a healed blaze.  
This point was not utilized during the course of this survey.
