Found - 30" now 38" dia., 5 ft. high D.Fir stump, we open
low & find scribing "BT" (1913)
1913 SE BT not found.

Set - 5/8" by 30" long iron rod with DCSO alum. cap
stamped "2002" at rec. position from 1913 BT.
Iron rod protrudes 9" above ground surround with
mound of stone. 1913 BT bears N.53¼°W., 25.1 ft.
Corner lies on steep south slope approx. 100 ft.
North of SW'ly running creek.

New - Chiseled 5" "X" on southerly face of a 3 ft. high by
8 ft. long sandstone out crop. "X" bears
N.37½°W., 7.1 ft.

13" dia., D.Fir single blazed & scribed "X CS BT"
bears S.85°W., 57.0 ft.

Double trunk Madrone single blazed & scribed "X CS
BT" on 6" dia., northerly trunk, bears S.67°E.,
3.6 ft. to center of scribed trunk.

17" dia., D.Fir single blazed & scribed "X CS BT"
bears N.56°E., 24.0 ft.

Compass decl. 17½°E.
