Set an Iron bar 1" x 40" and a rock for cor. No trees near.
Could find no trace of original tree. Located corner by
measurements.

Found - 1" square iron bar 6" below ground. (1921) Top leans
4" north east of plumb. Corner lies S.75°E., 7
ft. from intersection of fence lines. Fences run
N.75°W., N.8°W., & S.8°E.

Rock found at corner in 1921 survey (Vol. 3 pag. 89-
90) now gone.

OBT looked for, not found.

Set - 3 5/8"x30" long iron rods with alum. cap in fence
lines. Stamp alum. caps BO 1 2002, BO 2 2002, and
BO 2 2002.

BO 1 bears S.45°W., 7.7 ft.

BO 2 bears N.75°W., 50.0 ft.

BO 3 bears N.45°W., 10.7 ft.

No trees near.
