Searched for both M.C. along section line between S21 and S28. No evidence of bearing trees found.
A rough bearing tie was made to the East bank of the Umpqua River. A wide area was searched for evidence of bearing trees. Some large Cottonwood trees (possibly described as an Ash in original record) and a Myrtle tree were opened to search for blazes or scribing. No evidence was found. Location of search area was confirmed by staff compass tie run East for sec. cor. 20, 21, 28 and 29.
