Found - A "T" Iron set by Haines, protrudes 20" above ground. Found evidence of Fir tree, 1 ft. West of T Iron. A depression and fragmentary pieces of wood were located. Tree size indeterminable. T Iron is 1 ft. East of corner tree.
 Found fragmentary remains of stump, N.30°E., 12.8 ft. (Orig. record 10 lks.) size indeterminable, no scribing or blaze found.

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<p>Found depression in ground, S.70°E., 11.3 ft. (Orig. record, S.20°E., 14 lks.) Did not find monument set by Phillips at N.75°W., 64.0 ft.
