Found - An approx. 3x3" "X" scribed in top of the exposed portion of a rock which measures approx. 3 ft. by 4 ft. by 6 ft. A steel "PK" nail with a 1/2" dia., top is driven in center of fd "X" and protrudes 1/2" above rock surface.

No orig. BT evidence remains.

A 12" D.Fir now a 29" dia., D.Fir no longer showing blaze evidence; bears N.48°W., 6.8 ft. (as per rec.) 1959-61

New - A 10" dia. Madrone scribed "WC S23 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears N.50½°E., 17.0 ft.

An 18" dia. D.Fir scribed "WC S26 CS" "BT" on a double blaze; bears S.7½°E., 29.4 ft.

A 9" dia. Myrtle (most easterly trunk of a multi-trunk tree) scribed "X" "CSBT" on a high-low blaze. The center of the root-crown of the multi-trunk bears S.52½°W., 17.0 ft.

Also a 2" wide "U" shaped galvanized steel post protruding 4.5 ft. above ground; bears N.88°E., 4.9 ft.

Note - Monument is on top of highest right bank of the Umpqua River in older mixed forest of fir, madrone, myrtle and oak.

Compass decl. 15½°E.
