A 7" now 10" D.Fir bears N.89°E., 18.6 ft. (Rec. N.82°15'E., 17.2 ft.) Tree is well healed. (Haines BT)

Found fragmented scribing and copper washer at Haines' NW bearing tree, which is now down and shattered.
