Set Fir post for ¼ sec. cor., from which
A Fir 18" dia., bears N.20°E., 36 lks.
A Fir 16" dia., bears South, 9 lks.

Claude Kerr, Eng. #2125 - Corner report filed March 1949 - C.S. File 40/190

Found - Fir, South 6 lks., has ¼S inscribed on bark.
Fir, N.20°E. for 36 lks., is a windfall, scribe found.
Set 3" x 4 ft. Fir stake for ¼ corner.

Clyde Mulkins - for IP Timberlands - Jan. 4, 1994 - M 118-61

Found - 27" diam., D.Fir, with visible bark scribes, bears South, 5.9 ft.
Set I.P.T.O Alum. mon. (3/4" x 36" Alum. rod and 3" Alum. cap stamped "LS 2006") At the corner between secs. 25 & 36.
New BTs- 13" diam., D.Fir, bears N.49°E., 15.4 ft., I scribe "1/4 S25 BT".
10" diam., D.Fir, bears N.69°W., 14.9 ft., I scribe "1/4 S25 BT".
14" diam., D.Fir, bears N.10°W., 11.4 ft., I scribe "1/4 S25 BT".
Fd. a windfall D.Fir noted by Kerr CS 40/190, N.20°E., 36 lks.

Found - 3" IP Timberlands alum. cap dated 1994 with the following accessories:
31" D.Fir bears South 5.9' - bark scribing visible.
16" D.Fir bears N.49°E., 15.4' - healed face.
New - 15" D.Fir bears N.26°E., 17.7' - blazed, scribed "X BT"
8" D.Fir bears S.49°E. 7.5', blazed, scribed "¼ S36 BT"
Note - Corner has steel post adjacent to it. All BTs have red painted bands & yellow tags.
