A Fir 50" dia., bears N.25°W., 31 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT  
A Cedar 14" dia., bears S.77°W., 145 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S BT.

Douglas Co. Surveyors Office - James Byron, Deputy - April 23, 1956 - C.S. File 47/142

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Found - Orig. stone set for ¼ corner mkd. ¼ W. face, checks dist. and bearing to now 26" Cedar with face burned, no scribing visible.

Also found 60" Fir which bears N.48°E., 20.5 ft. (Rec. N.25°W., 20.5 ft.), scribe marks found on this BT.

Set an iron pipe with brass cap alongside orig. stone cor. and marked "County Surveyors Office 1956 ¼ S35 36 T23S R8W" from which

A 12" R.Fir S.50°E., 3.5 ft. scribed ¼ S36 CS BT.  
A 14" R.Fir S.78°W., 24.8 ft. scribed ¼ S35 CS BT.

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The ¼ sec. cor., perpetuated and recorded by Byron in 1956, subsequently recorded by Roberts in 1982, monumented with an iron post 1½" dia., firmly set, projecting 4" above ground, with brass cap mkd. in 1956, from which the remains of an original bearing tree

A Fir stump 56" dia., bears N.52°E., 31 lks. dist., no marks visible.

A Fir snag 14" dia., bears S.50°E., 5½ lks. dist. with healed blaze.

A Fir stump 18" dia., bears S.78½°W., 37 lks. dist. with healed blaze.

- 28" D.Fir stump bears S.78½°W., 24.4' - healed face
- 28" Hemlock bears S.43°W., 22.4' - healed face
- Steel post adjacent to corner
