Found - A 53" stump, 3' high, from which:
 A Fir, 15" diam., bears N.28°E., 13.0' dist. (rec. 13.6), with partially visible scribe and tag by "RH 419"
 A Fir, 11" diam., bears S.53°W., 17.7' dist, with partially visible scribe and tag by "NF 4-19"
New - An aluminum post at center of stump, on a distance-distance intersection from BTs.
 Cleared area of debris.
 Painted BTs with a 6" band at 6' high.
 Added ferrous nails at side center of BTs.
 Compass Declination 14½°E
