A Fir, 72" dia., bears N.70°W., 49 lks., mkd: ¼ S7 BT.

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Found - Post, now missing, from which  
8" Hemlock bears S.63°E., 35 lks.; now a 22" windfall, face exposed, scribes 4 S 7 visible.

Set - 1½"x36" galv. iron pipe with 3" brass cap mkd: "Ore. St. Bd. of Forestry ¼ S7 1967 RS 359", 34" in ground, and from which:  
12" Hemlock bears S.29°W., 23.5 ft. to face; scribed ¼ S7 BT RS 359.  
4" x 4" x 72" white painted Cedar post 1 ft NW of corner pipe. Ore. St. Forestry Dept. metal location poster on the 96" OBT
