Found - ½" iron pipe at cor. & I believe both BTs, each checks bearing, dist., size, age & specie as recorded - 1906 survey.
 10" now 16" Alder N.60°W., 2.6 ft. alive but well rotted. Face, open, I find no scribe marks.
 12" now 24" Maple S.69°W., 33.0 ft. I open & find rotted face but do find what I believe to be a 1½" section of curved (negative) scribe mark.
Set - Brass cap & rock mound at side of ½" IP, mkd:

 14" R.Fir bears N.51°W., 62.8 ft. scribed MC S2 T23S R10W CS BT.
